Transform your iPad into Laptop

Wireless Connection

- 1.When the keyboard is powered on, press the " weys on the keyboard, and the keyboard, and the keyboard will be in the waiting search atate within three minutes
- 2.Go to iPad "Settings", then turn on Bluetooth and keep "ON"
- 3.Search for keyboard wireless signal on other iPad devices "ipad Keyboard", click connect, "Connected" is displayed on the iPad and paired successfully
- *Note: start the second time and the bluetooth will be connected automatically.

Dower on and off

Power on / off: double click the switch button to power on / off.




Question about charging


*After the keyboard is successfully connected to the iPad, slide the screen to the right on the iPad home screen (the keyboard battery usage is displayed on the ipad.)

NOTICE: If you don't use it normally, please charge the keyboard regularly, once in a month is advised by keyboard.

Light indicator instructions

1.Blue LED: Blink at paring; Stays on after paired successfully. 2.White LED: Caps lock indicator.





Trackpad Gesture Description V3.0


One Finger



Tap: Press with one finger until it feels a little bit.




Tap and hold: Press and hold with one finger.



Drag: Tap and hold the item, then slide your finger on the touchpad to move it.



Open the Dock: Swipe the pointer across the bottom of the screen with one finger.



Go to the home screen: Swipe the pointer across the bottom of the screen with one finger. When the dock appears, swipe the pointer across the bottom of the screen again.




Open "Control Center": Move the pointer to the status icon in the upper right corner of the screen with one finger, then tap or swipe up again with one finger.



Open "Notification Center": Move the pointer to the status icon in the upper left corner of the screen with one finger, then tap or swipe up again with one finger.

Double Fingers



Scroll up or down: Swipe up or down with two fingers.



Scroll left or right: Swipe left or right with two fingers.




Zoom: Place two fingers close together, spread to zoom in, or pinch to zoom out.



Open search from the home screen: Swipe down with two fingers.



Turn on the Today view: When the home screen or lock screen is visible, swipe right with two fingers.



Auxiliary tap: Move the cursor to the APP icon with one finger, then tap or tap with two fingers to open the APP menu.

Three Fingers



Go to the home screen: Swipe up with three fingers



Open the APP switcher: Swipe up with three fingers, pause and then lift your finger.



Switch between open apps: Swipe right with three fingers, then swipe left or right to switch.

Notice:

- Operating system: IOS 15.0 and above (device must support touch).
- Tap Settings (after successful wireless pairing): Settings → General → Touchpad →
 Tap to tap / Two-finger assist point (open)
- Sensitivity setting(after successful wireless pairing): Settings→General→Touchpad→ Tracking speed (adjust to appropriate speed)
- Touchpad (no physical button style): No "drag" gesture function option.
- [fn]+ T

Turn on and off the touchpad function.
